

2018 Poland Invitational Track and Field classic
Saturday, April 28, 2018-9:00 AM
Poland Seminary High School Stadium

MEET INFORMATION:

1. Entry fees will be \$120 for a single team, \$235 if both boys and girls teams are entered. Entry fees must be paid not later than April 28, 2018. Entry fees must be mailed to: Poland Bulldog Track Club, PO Box 5296, Poland, OH 44514.
2. Teams must register prior to the meet with John Jeren Jr. on the Poland Invitational website, www.polandinvitational.com.
3. Entries must be made on www.baumspage.com in accordance with the online instruction information posted at www.polandinvitational.com.
4. The order of events will be on a rolling schedule and in accordance with the posted Order of Events. The order of events are posted at www.timingcrew.com and www.polandinvitational.com.
5. The starting high and minimum throw lines for shot and discus will be determined by the games committee prior to the start of the meet and will be posted at www.timingcrew.com. Long jump will be conducted using the open pit format. Minimum jump line will be determined by the games committee. Each long jumper will get three preliminary jumps with the top nine going to the finals. Each athlete in throws competition will have three preliminary throws with the top nine going to the finals.
6. All running events will be timed utilizing Finish Lynx and scored via HyTek Meet Manager. Live meet results will be posted on www.timingcrew.com. These results can be accessed on mobile devices that have access to the Internet. Poland will not provide Wi-Fi or other Internet services.
7. Scoring will be eight places as follows: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1. Metals will be awarded to the top three finishers with ribbons going to places 4-6. Team trophies will be awarded for the top three teams. Iron Bulldog trophies will be presented to the boy and girl scoring most points in the meet. Metals and ribbons will be placed in a bag in each coach must pick up their wards before leaving; they will not be mailed.
8. There will be no relay cards. Coaches are encouraged to bring any relay name changes to the scoring trailer whenever they have a change on a relay team as athletes will get credit for points in relay events. **Teams must bring their own starting block and batons.**
9. Tents will be permitted in areas specified by meet management. Assignments will be made upon entering the stadium. No tents will be permitted on or under the bandstand located on the south end of the stadium

10. An athletic trainer will be available at the 10th on the East finish line.
11. No athletes will be permitted on the football infield at any time. Coaches in the high jump and long jump will be issued passes to access the infield.
12. Semi final results and final results will be posted on the back of the West stands after each event. This information can also be accessed at www.timingcrew.com. Results will also be posted after each event on the stadium scoreboard
13. Hip numbers will be utilized in all events not finishing in a land, i.e. all distance races as well as the 4X 800 relay and 4X 400 relay.
14. Buses will be parked via instructions given to drivers upon arrival at the stadium. Athletes shall enter the stadium at the east side and coaches will be given their packets upon entry.
15. Any last minute athlete changes or substitutions shall be brought to the Timing Crew trailer as soon as possible BEFORE the meet starts.
16. **Coaches meeting** will be at 8:45 am in the southwest corner of the stands.
